

# SAFETY THINGS TO BE DONE AT HOME

## CUPBOARDS

Fix the cupboard door to prevent the dishes from falling.

## ELECTRIC LIGHTS

Fix with chains and metal fittings for hanging lamps. Tape both ends of the fluorescent lights.

## FIRE ALARM

Put on some fire alarm buzzers to let you know when there is smoke or fire. (bedrooms, stairs, kitchen and others.)

## WINDOW GLASSES

To avoid blowing away of broken glasses, stick them with window film or tape at the inside.

## CURTAIN

If possible use made of flame proof (hard to burn) curtains.

## BOOKSHELVES, CABINETS

Fix them with metal fittings to prevent from falling.

## T.V.

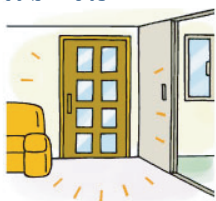
In a low portion where the T.V. is placed, use rope or metal fittings not to fall.

## HEATER

Make sure the heater you use has automatically stop attachment.
